Nationals COVID-19 Protocols

- In response to changing COVID-19 guidelines and recommendations, the NAIGC has revised it's [COVID-19 policies for Nationals](#).
- This policy applies to all Nationals attendees, including competitors, coaches, judges, volunteers, and spectators!
- Please carefully review all requirements and refer to this [FAQ](#) for any questions! Email nationals@naigc.org for any questions.

Nationals COVID-19 Protocols

- We will be using **CrowdPass to validate and confirm vaccination status**. If you are registered for Nationals or plan on attending, please submit your vaccine card via CrowdPass **before you arrive** in Milwaukee, instructions provided below. If you have an approved vaccine exemption, you will need to submit a negative COVID-19 test result via Crowdpass 24-48hr prior to attending Nationals (depending on test administered)
- The NAIGC is requiring **proof of vaccination**, or approved exemptions, **prior to receiving your National's badge** when your team checks in. If everyone registered on your team has submitted their proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test result, in accordance with the protocols outlined in the Nationals COVID-19 policies (linked in previous slide), to the CrowdPass platform, then a representative from your team will be allowed to pick up your team's materials from the registration table.
- Spectators will be required to show proof of vaccination at the door when they purchase admission. Vaccine exemptions will not be accepted for spectators.

Requirements for Attendees before the Event

All attendees will be required to show **proof of being fully vaccinated** against COVID-19.

- Fully vaccinated is defined as **two weeks after** the first shot of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine or the second shot of the Moderna or Pfizer Vaccines.

If a participant has been granted an exemption from being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 from their employer or school, they may email nationals@naigc.org with proof that they have been granted an exemption and the NAIGC will review and honor that exemption, if valid.

- If you are granted an exemption from being vaccinated, you will be required to submit proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 24 hours of the start of the event if it is an antigen test, or 48 hours from the start of the event if it is a PCR test.

The NAIGC recommends that all attendees be fully up to date with their COVID-19 vaccine series per CDC guidelines but is NOT requiring that everyone be boosted in order to attend Nationals.

The NAIGC will be reaching out to all participants prior to the start of the event to confirm vaccination or exemption status

Requirements for Attendees at the Event

Masks

- All attendees will be **required to wear** either a **KN95, KFN94, N95, surgical mask or medical procedure mask at all times** when they are in spaces organized by the NAIGC (competition hall, banquet hall, hospitality room, etc.)
- When competitors are actively warming up or actively competing, they will be allowed to **temporarily remove their mask** as long as they can maintain 6 feet distance from other participants while their mask is off.
- Any athlete who chooses to compete with a mask on will receive a 0.1 bonus per event (0.1 per E judge for T&T). The NAIGC wishes to encourage the use of masks and recognizes that those who choose to wear a mask while competing will most likely lower their difficulty level. We do not want competitors to be at a scoring disadvantage for choosing to remain protected from COVID-19.
- The NAIGC will have a limited number of surgical masks on hand for those who do not have access to one, but we recommend that you bring your own masks from home and use those when you travel to the event if you are using any form of public transportation (plane, bus, train etc.).
- Hand sanitizer will be available at multiple locations throughout the gyms. We kindly ask that all attendees maintain appropriate distance from others whenever possible and practice good hand hygiene.

Requirements for Attendees at the Event

Testing/ Symptoms at Event

- If attendees show **cold-like symptoms** during the event, they will be **asked to leave and quarantine** at a separate space until a COVID-19 test can be taken.
- If participants **test positive for COVID-19** during the event, they will be asked to inform event organizers of their positive test result, **leave the event and quarantine at a separate space** for the duration of Nationals.
- If any event organizer/manager is informed that someone tested positive during Nationals, an email will be sent out to all participants that says someone at the event has tested positive; the identity of the individual will be kept anonymous

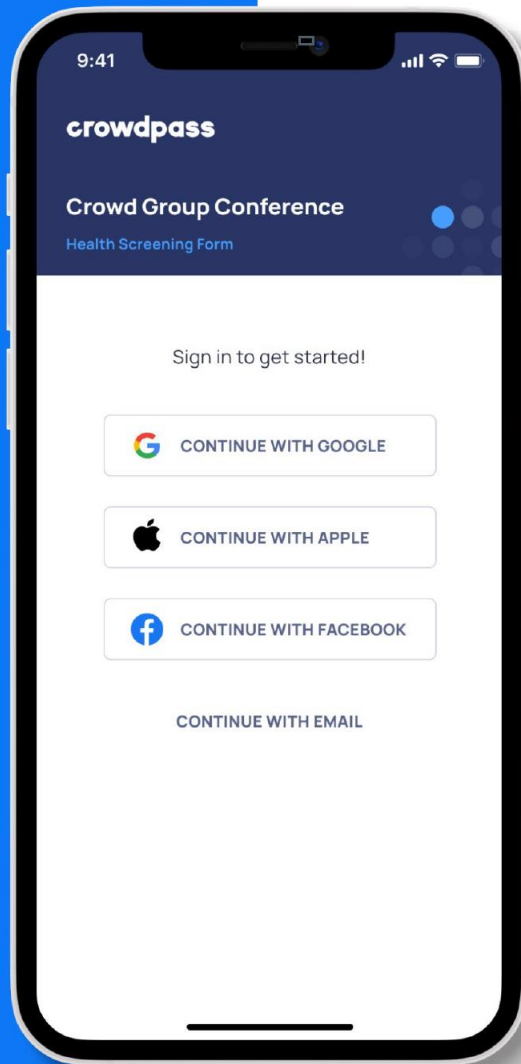

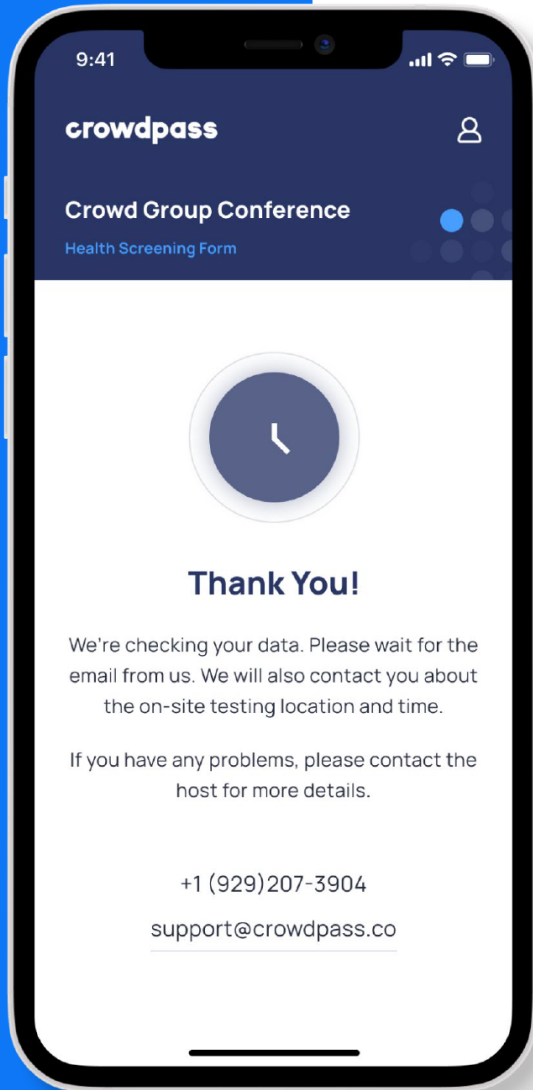

Once the user has filled out the health screening questions accurately, they will then be required to upload digital proof of full vaccination, negative test results or both.

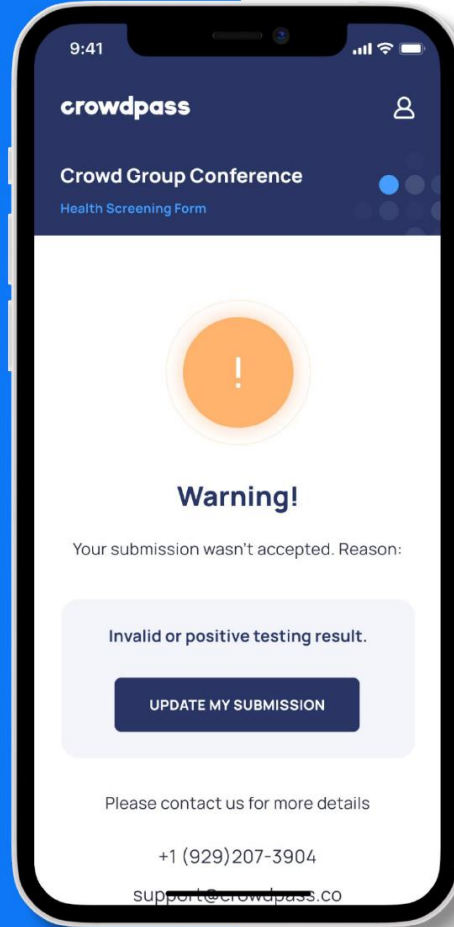
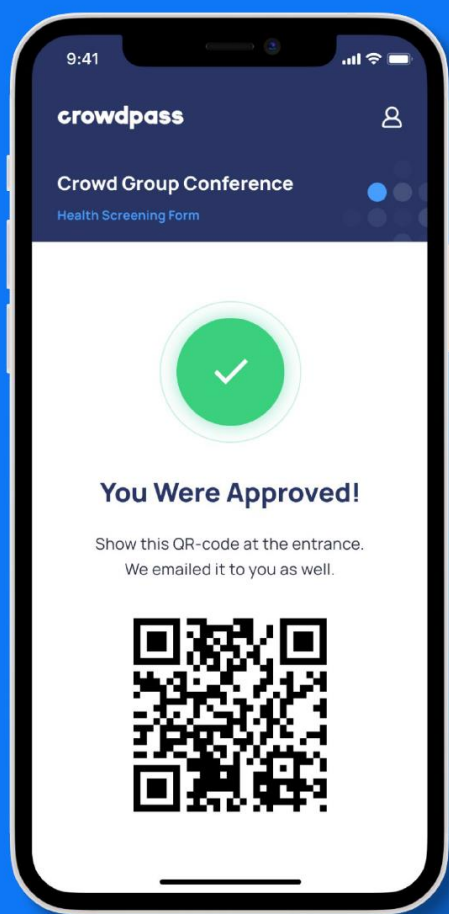
Health credentials must be accurate, legible and meet the guidelines required for that organizer, state, or region.



Pending Approval

Once the user has completed the health screening form and uploaded the necessary proof, they will receive an email from **CrowdPass**, pending approval.

This means The **CrowdPass** verification team is reviewing other submissions and will screen the users submission in a timely manner.



Approved or Rejected

Once the **CrowdPass** verification reviews your submission, you will either be approved or rejected.

Approved- You're good to go! The **CrowdPass** QR code will get you through the door.

Rejected- Your submission didn't meet the requirements and you will have to go through the submission process again
