

Club Membership Policy

- I. Purpose
 - A. This policy defines the guidelines for becoming an NAIGC member club.
- II. Definitions
 - A. Club: A group of individuals forming a team with a majority of members practicing together in the same gym or competing together in the current competitive season and has its own structure and leadership.
 - B. Special circumstances for groups that do not meet the above properties will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis by the NAIGC Board.
- III. Overview
 - A. Benefits of being an NAIGC member club include:
 - 1. Each NAIGC member club receives one ballot and may vote in the yearly NAIGC Board election.
 - 2. Eligibility to compete as a team at any NAIGC sanctioned event.
 - 3. Eligibility to host an NAIGC sanctioned event.
 - 4. Eligibility for NAIGC subsidized insurance.
 - B. Club Requirements:
 - 1. Pay the annual membership fee
 - 2. Advance the mission of the NAIGC by providing opportunities for participation in adult gymnastics.
 - 3. Uphold NAIGC Code of Conduct.
 - C. Membership and participation in NAIGC is a privilege and the NAIGC makes the sole determination of the status of its members. The NAIGC may limit or revoke any club's membership or participation at any time for any reason on a case-by-case basis.
- IV. The following information must be collected from (or confirmed by) member clubs on an annual basis:
 - A. Club name
 - B. Club contact information (phone number, email address, physical address)
 - C. The NAIGC may collect additional information as needed (i.e. practice schedule, disciplines offered, number of participants, coach status, competition status, etc.)
- V. Membership
 - A. Cost: **\$109** for each club membership
 - B. Duration: 1 Year, coinciding with the NAIGC fiscal year
- VI. Amendments

- A. This document may be amended by the Operations Leadership Team if the changes are minor. If the sum total of changes are big enough that a majority of members need to know about it, the changes must be approved by the NAIGC Board.
